The Data Protection Act 1998 gives you a general right of access to the information that relates to you. This right of access is known as your 'Subject Access Right'. It says that when recording and using information we must be open about how we use this information

Why would you need to access this data?

We endeavour to ensure all of our records are accurate and up to date. It is your right to inspect these if you wish and let us know if there are inaccuracies.

What is Personal Data?

Personal Data is defined as;

'Data which relate to a living individual who can be identified from those data, or from those data and other information which is in the possession of or is likely to come into the possession of the Data Controller, (i.e. Golden Gates Housing Trust), and includes any expression of opinion about the individual and any indication of the intentions of the data controller or any other person in respect of the individual.'

It includes anything held on computer or on paper and extends to images, including photographs and CCTV footage.

It includes data that is obtained, held or recorded, and any such data that is adapted, aligned, altered, blocked, combined, consulted, destroyed, erased, organized, retrieved, used, disclosed by transmission, disseminated or otherwise made available. All of these are loosely referred to as 'processing' of your data.

What are you entitled to?

A description of what personal data we are holding or processing,
The purposes for which it is being used,
Those to whom it may, or is, being disclosed,
A copy of all the information which makes up your personal data, via subject access request,
Any information as to the source of the data.

We are obliged to give you this in permanent form, subject to Golden Gates Housing Trust receiving the £10 fee and being satisfied you have reasonably confirmed your identity. A request can be refused if part of the information involves a third party who is unhappy to have their data disclosed, a similar request was recently complied with, or, it will involve a disproportionate effort.

We are entitled to withhold, or anonymise, any third party details or exempt information within your data.
